

PROPOSED MINUTES BIRCH RUN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

OCTOBER 8, 1985

A motion of amend the following budget areas: township center supplies from \$350 to \$600, fire department from \$2500 to \$3500 and weed control from \$2500 to \$3500 by transfer from contingency by motion of Scharrer, supported by Dorr. Motion carried.
