

ORDINANCE NO. 84-1

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A CODE OR ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BIRCH RUN FOR NON-TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

THE TOWNSHIP OF BIRCH RUN ORDAINS:

The position of Code or Ordinance Enforcement Officer is hereby created who shall be appointed by the Township Board and shall serve at the sole pleasure of the Township Board. The Code Enforcement Officer shall be authorized to issue and serve appearance tickets as defined in M.S.A. 28.868 through 28.868 (7) for violations of all Township Ordinances except traffic related Ordinances, when the Code Enforcement Officer has reasonable cause to believe that a person, or party, has committed a violation of a non-traffic Ordinance of the Township. The Code Enforcement Officer shall further take such additional actions as are permitted by law to secure compliance with Township non-traffic Ordinances.

Effective date: This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication as provided by law.
