

MINUTES REGULAR BIRCH RUN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

FEBRUARY 15, 1985

(Rescheduled from Feb. 12 due to road conditions)

The regular February meeting of the Birch Run Township Board rescheduled due to heavy snow from Feb. 12 to Feb. 15 was called to order at 1:10 p.m. by Supervisor James Totten. Also present were Clerk Marcia Strong, Treasurer Edgar Scharrer and trustees Alvin Block and Jim Dorr.

Minutes of the regular January meeting were read by the clerk. Motion to approve as read and mailed was made by Block and supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

Bills as attached were presented by the clerk.

A motion to pay the bills as presented was made by Dorr, supported by Block. Motion carried.

Supervisor reported that commercial re-assessment is underway. Cost will be about \$7500.

Supervisor explained status of Jim Forester, George Schmunk water line.

A motion to deny the request of George Schmunk to waive his tap in fee for the second house was made by Dorr, supported by Block. Motion carried.

The low bid of R.F. Murray and Co. for the township's annual audit for two years was accepted by motion of Strong, supported by Block. Motion carried.

Fire Department's annual report was presented by the Supervisor.

A motion to alter the library budget in the following areas was made by Dorr, supported by Block. Motion carried.

Increase AV by \$500 by transfer from salaries.

Increase utilities by \$500 by transfer from salaries.

Increase professional and contractual services by \$65.

Increase repair and maintenance by \$50 thru transfer from operating supplies.

Increase books by \$500 due to increase in donations.

Office hours and help were again discussed.

Motion to adjourn was made at 2:25 by Strong, supported by Scharrer. Motion carried.
