A motion to hold regular township board meetings on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p. m. was made by Schaner and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to retain the Buck Run Branch of the Frankemuth State Bank as the depository for funds of the township was made by Foster and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to give the Park Board a ^{13,000 allocation} when they request it was made by Strong supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to give the Frankemuth Recreation Board \$500 was made by Foster and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to give the Buck Run Athletic Association a \$1,000 allocation was made by Schaner and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

The motion to adopt the budget as presented at the annual meeting was made by Schaner and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously. A copy is attached to the minute book.

Because of the evaluation ^{approaching} ~~reaching~~ 25 million the township must start publishing minutes of all meetings. The Clerk will take care of this.

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A motion to allow the treasurer and clerk to buy 3 binders and one gross paper was made by Schaner and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.
