Board recessed meeting for five minutes so clerk could consult with AV Counting Board.

A motion to accept the bills as presented was made by Foster, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor presented rezoning requests of Don Frey and County and Township recommendations on this request. Frey's attorney made a presentation requesting the rezoning from B-2A to B-2.

Clerk left meeting at this point to close the polls. (8-8:05 p.m.)

Motion by Strong that township board agree with recommendations of two planning commissions and deny request of Frey to rezone from B-2A to B-2 was made by Strong supported by Scharrer. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor presented rezoning request of Lawrence R. Fisette to rezone land on Gera Road from A-2 to B-2A. Motion to deny request was made by Foster. and supported by Scharrer. Motion passed unanimously.

Copies fo Planning Commisssion's recommendations are attached.

Harold Johnson made a presnetation in relation to his request for an EDC grant to expand his facilities on Dixie Hwy. The board had no objectmons to his plans.

Robert Worley, 4th district commissioner, spoke briefly.

A letter from Robert Young requesting we contact our State Legislator in reference to SB was read by the supervisor.

The supervisor read a letter from the DPW requesting nominees for positions on Solid Waste Management Planning Committee. The township board members will attempt to come up with candidates.

White Pine Library co-operative contract was read by the supervisor. Motion to sign contract was made by Strong and supported by Foster. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting recessed for 15 minutes so clerk could total vote and contact court house and news media.

Auditors presented their annual report.

Clerk left at 9 p.m. to take election results into Saginaw. Treasurer Edgar Scharrer assumed minute books duties.

Motion to adjourn was made by Roger Foster and supported by Alvin Block at 9:20. Motion passed unanimously.
