Alvin Block moved and Foster supported that the supervisor be allowed to spend \$200 rather than the previously allotted \$100 for an answering machine for the trap center. The motion passed unanimously.

Roger Foster moved and Alvin Block supported to spend \$14,505 of revenue sharing on the park and the other \$6,000 on roadside drainage. The motion passed unanimously.

Alvin Block moved and Scherer supported that we give the inspector the \$10 from the county on seepage field permits. The motion passed unanimously.

Scherer made motion and Block supported to buy reprint of 1981 History of Saginaw County, Michigan for \$19.76. The motion passed unanimously.

Scherer moved and Block supported that we sell to the highest bidder the MJD 8-Door ^{over \$50} Bicentennial proposals were read. They will be discussed at the June meeting.

Scherer made the motion to adjourn and Foster supported. The motion passed unanimously.
