

RESOLUTION

RELATIVE TO RECOVERY OF INDUSTRIAL WASTE TREATMENT COST

At a regular meeting of the Board of the Township of Birch Run, Saginaw County, Michigan, on April 12, 1977, at which the following members were present Laurance Courtney, Marcia Stung, Edgar Schaner and Roger Foster and Alvin Block and _____ were absent, it was moved by Foster and seconded by Schaner that the following resolution be adopted.

WHEREAS, treatment of the waste from the Township service area will be in the Village of Birch Run waste treatment facility, which will be constructed in part with Federal funds, and,

WHEREAS, at the present time there are no industries in the Township contributing significant industrial wastes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Board of Birch Run hereby assures the Environmental Protection Agency that an industrial waste cost recovery system, satisfactory to the Environmental Protection Agency, will be enacted to recover the cost allocated to any industrial waste treated in the future.
