The following preamble and resolution were moved for adoption by <a href="DiBerardino">DiBerardino</a> and the motion was supported by <a href="Russell">Russell</a>:

# RESOLUTION REGARDING CERTAIN PROPOSED WATER IMPROVEMENTS AND RELATED SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the Township Board (the "Board") of the Township of Birch Run, Saginaw County, Michigan (the "Township"), is entering into a Contract for the construction of water improvements (the "Project") with the County of Saginaw (the "County") pursuant to Act No. 185 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1957, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Bartow & King Engineers, Bay City, Michigan, have prepared and submitted to the Township preliminary plans describing the Project and its location in the Township (the "Plans") and a preliminary estimate of the cost of the Project (the "Cost Estimate"); and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the Contract, the Plans and the Cost Estimate, the Township Board desires to proceed with the Project, to levy special assessments against the lands specially benefitted by the Project to defray all or part of the cost of the Project, all pursuant to and as authorized by Act No. 185, Michigan Public Acts of 1957, as amended ("Act 185"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Assessor is preparing and will certify a proposed special assessment roll (the "Roll") for the Water Assessment District (the "District"), and the Roll will be filed with the Township Clerk at least 10 days prior to March 14, 1995;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Plans and the Cost Estimate are accepted, approved and ordered filed with the Township Clerk, and the summary thereof attached to this resolution as EXHIBIT A is hereby approved and made a part of this resolution.

- 2. The Township Board hereby tentatively declares its intention to construct the Project and tentatively designates the special assessment district named and described in EXHIBIT B against which all or part of the cost of the Project is to be assessed.
- 3. The Township Board instructs the Township Assessor to certify that (a) the Roll was prepared in accordance with the Township Board's direction, and (b) the Roll was prepared in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, including the Act, and the Assessor shall file the Roll with the Township Clerk not later than March 14, 1995.
- 4. The Board shall meet at 7:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday, March 14, 1995, at the Township Hall during such meeting shall conduct a public hearing to hear objections to the Projects and the Districts as required by law. The form of notice attached hereto as EXHIBIT B is hereby approved as and for the form of notice for such hearing. The Clerk shall cause notice of such hearing, in the form hereby approved to be given as follows:
  - To each record owner of, or party in interest in, land in the Districts whose name appears on the last Township tax assessment records (as defined below), by first-class mail addressed to such owner or party at such address, at least 10 days before the date of the hearings, provided, however, that if a record owner's name does not Township tax assessment the last in records, such notice shall be given by first-class mail addressed to the record owner at the address shown by the records of the address shown by the records of the Saginaw County Register of Deeds within the time provided in this subparagraph (a);
  - (b) By publishing such notice twice in a newspaper circulating in the Township, the first such publication in each newspaper to be at least 10 days before the date of the hearings; and
  - (c) To each person (if any) whose name and address has been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Michigan as a person upon whom may be served notice of any proceedings under Act 188 of the Public Acts of 1954, as amended, by registered mail addressed to such person at such address, or personally, within five days after the first publication of notice pursuant to subparagraph (b) of this paragraph.

As used in subparagraph (a) of this paragraph, the term "<a href="last">last</a> Township tax assessment records" means the last assessment roll for ad valorem tax purposes which was reviewed by the Township

Board of Review, as supplemented by any subsequent changes in the names or the addresses of the owners or parties listed on such roll.

- 5. In addition to the notices required by paragraph 3 of this resolution, public notice of the meeting referred to shall be given in compliance with the Open Meetings Act (Act No. 267, Public Acts of Michigan, 1976, as amended).
- 6. All previous resolutions, or parts of previous resolutions, of the Board that are inconsistent with this resolution are hereby rescinded.
