Motion by Stewart, supported by Henige to approve the minutes of the October 22, 1996 Special Meeting as read. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Stewart, supported by St. Charles to approve the payment of current invoices totaling \$78,628.81. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Stewart, supported by DiBerardino to approve the Burnham and Flower bid for township's insurance for 1997 for \$13,793 plus worker's comp. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by DiBerardino, supported by Henige to approve budget adjustments increasing General Fund Revenue \$ 26,100, increasing General Fund Expenditures \$25,210, increasing Water Fund Revenues \$10,000, increasing Water Fund Expenditures \$2,800, as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by DiBerardino, supported by St. Charles to approve approximately \$2325 for Gove Associates to have all township waterlines mapped. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by St. Charles, supported by Henige to confirm appointment of Wallace Rottiers and Duwayne Zobel to four year terms on the Township DDA effective November 12, 1996. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by DiBerardino, supported by Stewart to request Saginaw County simplify sections 3.1 and 3.2 of county house numbering ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.

Supervisor's Report: 1. Bonds for force feed line to Genesee County were sold today at 5.56% interest, purchased by Montrose State Bank, construction to begin around Dec. 1; 2. Elms Road Bridge should be finished by end of month; will cost \$9500 to move water line, township will pay half.
