- 8 New business Ryan McReynolds has asked to be on this committee, Fred said, Ryan is now a member.
- 9 Update on the Train, the school is building is actually started, the funds required for this is \$1,200.00
- and has been paid to the school
- 11 Discussion on park opening... Brad Thomas explained the Park opening schedule.
- 12 Discussion on the meeting dates for the Park Board... The consensus is the 3rd Tuesday @ 7pm in the
- 13 Township Government room
- 14 Old Business:
- 15 Concession structure Fred spoke on the concession structure and the units we spoke to over the last
- 16 week or so..... Prices range from \$12,500 down to \$5,200
- 17 10 X 20 pole barn style steel roof sides wood trusses 42 inch door 2X10 skirt \$2550.00
- 18 Concrete 3.5" deep \$325.00 plus about the same for labor... Brad says we have \$7,400 left in the costs
- 19 yet to be spent for the playground area... 6" compacted sand base then 9" of pea stone 3 tiers of
- 20 timbers to retain the sand and stone. This area is 48' X 44'. Brad spoke on the need for fall zones and
- 21 other requirements that are necessary for these types of toys. The total cost for the playground
- 22 equipment and finishing the area is \$9,250.00. The diggers are already purchased, the hardware for
- 23 mounting these is already purchased, the set up and welding of the mounts is already done.
- 24 From last meeting, we discussed purchasing the vending supplies and having the school assist and
- 25 manage the accounting for the vendors if possible.
- 26 Fred spoke on the advantage of a permanent structure again...
- 27 Question on the pros and cons for a trailer or permanent structure... Discussion on the power
- 28 requirements and available power in the park followed. A small generator could suffice if the mobile
- 29 unit is decided on. Discussion also followed on the potential for remote sales such as at the county fair
- and the BR 4th of July events as well as others.

31	Fred suggested that the Park Board wait until the actual 2012 Twp. Budget numbers to make a decision
32	on the building/trailer issue. Brad asked if the park committee is committed to the installation of the
33	playground equipment. The committee agrees that there have been commitments to people and
34	agencies in the community to install the playground equipment and we should stay on this tact. Again
35	discussion followed on the amount of monies that remains in the budget for the Park. Fred tabled the
36	building / trailer on the grounds that this committee needs the accurate accounting on the budget for
37	the park.
38	We discussed the total acreage that is recommended by the National Park Service for a given population
39	and that there is a recommended number of acres for a given population and that we are at a
40	deficit according to the recommendations.
41	Discussion also followed on the potential of using the summer taxes to send survey notices out to the
42	taxpayers of the community.
43	Discussion followed on the problems associated with the scheduling of games and how do we get the
44	usage under control. Fred suggested the Township send a letter out to the users of the park on
45	Twp letterhead we need to send everyone, every group that uses the park to attend the March
46	20 th meeting. Ramon discussed the problems with the scheduling and spoke on the problems
47	with regional scheduling for some of the events
48	It seems the parking of cars is the most serious issue!!!!!!! Perhaps, we need to look at the extension of
49	the parking lots to look at extra parking.
