A motion to increase inspectors fees from 10 to 15 per inspection was made by Scharrer, supported by Dorr. Rates for permits will be raised accordingly.

A motion to purchase a van for \$1800 from Tim Courtney for workfare program was made by Dorr, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor will hire a local foreman at township expense at \$5 per hour for this program.

A motion passed to adjourn was made at 4 p.m. by Strong, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.
