MINUTES REGULAR MAY MEETING

May 10, 1977

The motion to pay the bills as read was made by Foster supported by Block The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to buy a used diesel tractor from Bader Brothers for \$8,000 was made by Foster supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

The superviosr read the county planning commission's recommendation on rezoning application of Craig Baranowski. They recommended denial concurring with our local township planning commission. A motion to deny the request was made by Scharrer, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor explained the reasons for changing from Beyer to Pagels Road for the 1977 road project.

The supervisor explained the extension of the water main on Elms Road from Birch Run Road to Canada Roads. A motion topetition the Saginaw County Board of Public Works to acquire and construct 5,280 lineal feet of 8 inch watermain extension to Birch Run Water System on Elms Road from Birch Run Road to Canada Road within Birch Run Township. Further, all costs for said extension to be paid from surplus bond proceeds from the Birch Run Water Supply System now on hand with the county was made by Scharrer, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor reported on bids for the new 24 x 40 building to be built on the north side of the present building creating an **L** shaped building. Wickes Corporation \$4,434.87 and Farm Bureau \$4468.23. A motion to let the bid to Wickes was made by Strong supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adopt that portion of the budget pertaining to revenue sharing was made by Foster, supported by Scharrer. The motion passed unanimously.

A resolution to adopt the Michigan Energy Code was made by Strong and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously. see attached copy.

A motion to adopt the 1975 edition of the National Electric Code was made by Block, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously. A

copy of the ordinance is attached.

A motion to adopt the uniform building code of 1976 was made by Stronger supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously. A copy of the ordinance is attached.

Amotion to adopt the uniform plumbing code of 1976 was made by Scharrer, supported by Block. The mostion passed unanimously. A copy is attached.

The supervisor reported that the cemetery building is under construction.

The supervisor read a letter from the DPW in relation to the Step I Facilities Grant-Study and our rebuttal letter. Copies are attached.

The motion to adjourn was made by Scharrer and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.
