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Mr. Robert Thompson approached the board about getting water for the Shady Oaks subdivision area.

A motion to sell the fire dept's ¹⁹⁶⁴ ~~old~~ van through sealed bids at a minimum bid of \$750 was made by Schaner and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to reappoint Ed Cused to the Board of Appeals for a three year term was made by Foster and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to buy three games for Board of Review members was made by Schaner and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to pay \$15 dues for supervisor to Michigan Assessors Association was made by Schaner, supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor Courtney reported that an injunction has been issued against Mr. Lopez to "cease and desist" his junk yard operation within 20 days of Jan. 3.

A motion to approve the changes in the zoning ordinance proposed by our zoning board of appeals was made by Schaner and supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to change the road building program to delete Hammond and Brenner Roads from the road program and add ^{the} ~~the~~ Stone half

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mile of Beyer from Canada to Downing Roads was made by Scharrer and supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor reported on his dealings with the equalization dept. on the timber cut over reassessment. He has not been able to get a change on the land without building

Bob Worley and Ben Schraeder came in at this point to explain their willingness to serve us through the county commission.

The motion to adjourn was made at 9:20 by Foster, supported by Scharrer. The motion passed unanimously.
