Park has \$3400 left of grant to use up. Decision made to
postpone plans to run electricity to the pavilion so that
prices can be checked into.

Ken Savage reports that Cardinal Inn Motel owner has been
complaining of people on his property. If it continues
we must put up no parking signs, possibly a fence. To
put up a pipe Champagne & Marx want \$3000. Plans discussed
to buy pipe and have locals install it.

Ken Hobson gave Don Bailer \$80.00 from tennis meter.

Ken Savage reports on bleachers. We can get bleachers
that seat 160 people for around \$2400.

Don Bailer says he will pursue blockade plans for the park.

Ken Savage will check Dick Schmitzer for electrical work
and get a price.

John Fierstein makes motion to get bleachers. Sec'nd by
Ken Hobson.

Don Bailer raises question as to the meaning of a check
received from Schian, and says he will check into it.

Jerry Horan reports that girls Regionals and State softball
games might be held at the park.

Members of the Park Board went up to the park to check out
blockade, electric, and bleacher situations.
