Birch Run Community Park Board Minutes for October 18, 1976

John Fierstein made a motion to pay a 2 month Consumer Power bill of \$11.54. Cindy Fent seconded the motion. All favored.

James Frank reported the Lions Club had used the park on September 11, 1976. The key was picked up by Wayne Young for the restroom, the water was not turned on, the park was not cleaned after their outing. The key was not returned on time.

Don Bailer made a motion the board keep the damage deposit made by the Lions Club. Seconded by Fran Cuthberson.

Fran Cuthberson made a motion to pay James Frank \$15.00 for supplies for restrooms at the park. Cindy Fent seconded. All favored.

James Frank made a motion to contact Emil Zuellig to winterize restrooms at the park, seconded by John Fierstien. All Favored.

The next Park Board meeting will be called in November after the light poles arrive. It will be held at the park. Members will be called.

Don Bailer made a motion to close the meeting, seconded by John Fierstien. All favored.
