A motion to pay the bills as read was made by Foster, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor reported that he found there would be no charges for 911 emergency number. A motion of support for 911 as emergency number for Saginaw County and Birch Run Township was made by Foster, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor reported on status of HB 5119 and 5152. 5119 has passed House and is now in Senate Committee. State Library will "grandfather" Birch Run And Taymouth libraries into recognition as library if Dodak drops HB 5152. Supervisor read letter from Senator Young supporting both bills.

Clerk presented bids of \$6,087.25 from Library Bureau and \$3,751.50 from Doubleday for additional library equipment. Bid of Doubleday was accepted by motion of Foster, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously. Clerk will place order with payment not available until April.

Motion to close library on Christmas and New Year's Eves in addition to the regular holiday closing was made by Strong supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

A resolution requesting that Central Dispatch send C-M ambulance of Clio or Frankenmuth Ambulance on emergency calls to Birch Run Township depending upon which is closest to the emergency was made by Block supported by Foster. Motion passed.

Supervisor reported that exmess funds in Water System #2 will be used to extend water lime across Gera, down Camada Road to Johnson property.

A motion to adjourn was made by Foster and supported by Block at 8:45 p.m.
