## REGULAR MEETING OCTOBER 10, 1995

Resolution 95-11 and 95-12 were read. Discussion, questions, and comments were heard for approximately two hours. Motion by DiBerardino, supported by St. Charles to approve Resolution 95-12 which reaffirms Resolution 95-11, to Initiate Sewer Connection Project. Motion carried 7-0.

The board conducted a preliminary plat review for the Rausch commercial subdivision. Scott Rausch reviewed the project and answered questions from the board and audience. Motion by St. Charles, supported by Stewart to approve preliminary plat review for Rausch commercial subdivision. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Stewart, supported by Russell to approve new trash collection rate from People's Garbage of \$101.88 per year per household. Motion carried 6-1.
