Motion to pay the bills as read was made by Scharrer, supported by Block, Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor read most recent planning commission minutes.

Supervisor informed board that we must adopt mechanical code by April 1, 1980. An additional permit and inspector will be required. Supervisor is currently looking for an inspector.

A resolution requesting that the MTA, Rep. Dodak, Sen. Young, and Rep. Crim support HB 5119 and 5152 was made by Scharrer supported by Block. The motion passed unanimously. The entire board wishes to go on record as supporting these two bills.

A letter from the East Central Michigan Planning Commission was read by the supervisor. The letter discussed area wide plans for clean water.

A resolution in regards to this was proposed by Scharrer and supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously. A copy of that resolution is attached.

County Commissioner Robert Worley explained the new 911 emergency call idea. Supervisor will investigate cost of this. Mr. Gary Hutchinson approached the board about package beer and wine licenses in the township. The board explained that this matter is not in the hands of the township.

A motion to adjourn was made at 9:25 p.m. by Scharrer, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.
