The motion to approve payment of these bills was made by Schaner and supported by Block. Unanimous approval was given.

A motion to extend the contract with Peoples Garbage for another year at an annual rate of \$6030 was made by Foster and supported by Block. Unanimous approval was given.

Peoples Garbage would want \$32,160 to have trap wide pickups. If trap residents want this service, a special election to approve and determine method of payment is required. Such an election is brought about by petition.

The planning commission's recommendation in regards to Mr. Daniels' request was explained by Marie Strong, clerk. Schaner made a motion to support their recommendation. Foster supported it. Unanimous approval was given. The trap is investigated Federal flood insurance programs. MESC has informed the trap that they must provide unemployment compensation for their employees.

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Township has option on whether to pay percent each pay roll or pay benefits when situation arises. Second option was chosen.
