For example any development with less than approximately 5 homes would be cost prohibitive to develop. For example anything over 9 homes would be class county road. There is a concern when there is a need for access of fire trucks, and or emergency vehicles along with maintenance issues. Standards need to be in place to address these concerns. Maintenance issues would be worked out to accomplish bringing it up to code and billed and or a lien if builder or association does not bring it up to code. Need to have engineering code built to specs.
