A motion to hire Lane and Appold as
the township auditors was made by Foster,
supported by Block. The motion passed
unanimously.

A motion to amend the ~~Township~~ Repair

made by Schauer, supported by Block. The
motion passed unanimously.

A motion to amend the ~~Township~~ capital
outlay budget from \$500 to \$2500 was made
by Schauer and supported by Foster. The
motion passed unanimously.

The ~~Treasurer~~ reported that the budget is
running on target so far this year.

A motion to reappoint Nan Bailey as
