Meeting

Present: gary, Ed, Frank, Pam , and Jack Cramer

Park gates were discussed. When to open and close them was a major issue. A suggestion was made by Jack of putting heavy gates - equal to the other new set - be put in to replace the damaged one by the skating rink. It was felt by the board that if the Village wants to run the park, they should be prepared to take on the responsibilities that go with it. It was understood that the gates would be open daily, 7a.m. - 10p.m. - but it wasn't decided who would be taking on this responsibility. A meeting can be set up between the Village and the Park Board if it was needed and wanted. Jack said that problems at the park do not start to arise until dark, continuing until 4a.m. Ed made a move to open the gates right away until a decision could be made at the February 13th Village Council Meeting. It was proposed that Jack will close the gates at his own leisure and Tim Courtney could open them in the morning on his way to work. Ed McNamara will take this issue to the Village Meeting to discuss this.

Quotes on the repair of the fence will be received and handed to the Village as a result of the retaliation of the big gates.

Softball repairs and the dugouts were also talked about.

Pavilion improvements may also be made.

\$38.54 for utility lighting is the only bill due.
