A motion to extend the contract with People's Garbage for \$7,070.04 for the 1978 fiscal year was made by Strong supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to approve the two PAll6 applications of John Kraynak was made by Scharrer, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

Bids for the library/health center were discussed.

The Jasinski Builders representative, R. Oliver, went through his proposal.

The Supervisor read the proposals from Wolgast and Koepke.

A discussion on the bids followed.

A motion to table the decision until a special meeting on Monday, April 17, 1978 was made by Strong, supported by Scharrer. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adjourn was made by Strong at 9:15, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.
