~~This~~ in the winter of 1976. The supervisor requested authority to spend the money to go to the Tax Tribunal in protest over this ^{on record} ~~issue~~ ^{situation}. The motion to allow this was made by Schaner, supported by Foster. The motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor reported that all county supervisors will meet at 2:30 on May 13 to plan action against the county resolution to usurp township rights. The resolution asks the state's permission to allow a county to supersede the township's ruling on land use.

A resolution naming Peter Basolo as our agent in obtaining federal funds for storm damage clean-up was made by ~~Shaner~~ ^{Shaner} and supported by Schaner. The motion passed unanimously. A copy of the resolution is attached.

~~A special use motion to approve a special use permit for a commercial animal kennel for the next year (and on past) rather than was made by Foster and supported by Schaner. The motion passed unanimously.~~

The board agreed to allow the clerk to investigate buying an additional voting machine.

The board approved the treasurer's depositing general funds in duly interest saving accounts.

Don Bailes, planning commission chairman, reported on progress of the master plan and

Mr. Bailer also reported that the park has received a \$47,000 DNR grant. This is a matching funds grant.

Mr. Frahm came at this point and reported that the resolutions causing townships concern will be sent to the DPW committee and hopefully die a natural death there.
