A motion to adopt the budget as presented at the annual meeting was made by Strong, supported by Block. Motion passed unanonomously.

A rezoning request for an area on Gara Froad between Burt and Birch Run Roads was made by Tom Fox and Ed Magnus. Local planning approves. County planning recommends approval with note that all frontage from Clark Fox south to subdivision be rezoned to R2. The township board by motion of Block, supported by Scharrer agrees with rezoning following county recommendations. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion to amend the cable tv ordinance in relationto payments and correcting problems was made by Stronga nd supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously. A copy of the ordiance is attached.

A motion to amend trailer ordinance to say trailers msut be a minimum of 14 ft in width was made by Scharrer, supported by Dorr. Motion passed unanimously. A copy is attached.

The PA 116 application of Wilmar and Leona Rodammer was approved by motion of Dorr supported by Scharrer. Motion passed unanimously.

The supervisor reported tha tthe Planning Commission will hire John Mersman to direct rezoning.

A motion to use the Birch Run Office of Frankenmuth Bank and Trust was made by Scharrer, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion to reappoint Kevin Lincoln as liquor inspector for 83-84 was made by Block, supported by Scharrer. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion to meet the second Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p.m. at 8411 Main Street, Birch Run was made by Dorr, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.
