Motion by McKay, supported by Hadsall to pay invoices totaling \$35,990.27. Motion carried 7-0.

Township Attorney Bill Reising was present and presented a letter to the board stating the township may accept \$1000 payment for farming activities at the park. Motion by DiBerardino, supported by McKay to accept \$1000 payment from Mr. Keyes for farming at the park. Motion carried 6-1.

The Township Park Committee presented a proposal to the Board to build two ball diamonds on park land currently farmed, an additional pavilion, and apply for a grant to build a bike path/walkway to the park. Motion by DiBerardino, supported by McKay to approve \$45,000 from 1998-99 excess revenues to build two ball diamonds and a pavilion at the park. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Hadsall, supported by DiBerardino to appoint Dustin Belill, Kevin Schmitzer, James Saunders and Steve Mulcahy to the Birch Run Township Fire Department. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Magnus, supported by Stewart to amend the Fire Department's budget by increasing capital outlay \$60,000 from 1998-99 excess revenues. Motion

Mattion by DiBerardino, supported by Stewart to accept Burnham and Flower quote for township's insurance for \$18,649 for one year. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by McKay, supported by Hadsall to set the garbage rate for 1999 at \$107.40 per year per residence. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by DiBerardino, supported by Stewart to adjourn at 7:34 pm. Motion carried 7-0.
