Supervisor read a letter from County Road Commission in relation to federal funding on bridges, Bridges in Birch Run Township under consideration were Block and Reese Roads over Dead Creek.

A motion to petition the Road Commission to have anew bridge on Block, supported by Foster. Moiton passed unanimously.

Motion to support Road Commission in reguest for funds for new bridge over Dead Creek was made by Foster, supported by Block. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor reported that refuse pick-up information and routes will be sent out in November.

A motion to raise hydrant rental to \$50 per yeart per hydrant beginning with the April 1, 1980 fiscal year was made by Foster, supported by Scharrer. Motion passed unanimously.

Arequest from the Billage Council for use of construction funds for payment of costs of land and other costs in relation to pumping station was presented by the Supervisor.

Amotion to approve the request from the village with the stipulation that the townshp must have name on deed to the land in same proportion as it is paying for it was made by Strong, supported by Foster. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor reported on status of Frey case. Mr. Frey is currently bringing more equipment onto the property.

Motion by Foster, supported by Scharrer at 8:30 to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
