Motion by Strong, supported by Scharrer to appoint Gary Hutchinson and to reappoint Carl Kern to the Board of Review for two year terms. Motion carried.

Motion by Strong, supported by Foerster to reject the Birch Run Area School's proposal to pay \$1 per parcel for summer tax collection and to counter propose that they pay actual costs as Clio Area Schools does with a pre-agreed cap. Motion carried.

Motion by Foerster supported by T. Totten to authorize Roberts, Bartow, and Associates to prepare specifications for water line extensions on Townline Road from end of line to Dehmel Road, on Pagels and Downing Roads from end of line on Canada Road to Block Road and on Beyer Road approximately 800 ft. south of the village limits.

Motion by Strong, supported by Foerster to begin legal action against Helen Moored of 10111 Wenn Road for violation of the township's zoning ordinance in relation to junk vehicles. Motion carried.

Supervisor discussed DDA's. Board will have a special meeting with township engineer Gary Bartow on Jan. 30 at 7:30 p.m. to discuss forming a DDA in the proposed sewer district.

Motion by T. Totten, supported by Scharrer to adjourn at 8:30 p.m. Motion carried.
