Supervisor reported on water service agreement to service Maple road extension inot Frankenmuth Township. Contract will be presented to board at a later date after suggested corrections are made.

Supervisor reported that Pfeffer rezoning request was recommended for denial by local and county planning commissions. Pfeffer presented his side of the issue.

A motion to deny Pfeffer's rezoning request was made by Strong supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

New Social Security medicare witholdings was discussed. Motion to purchase fund Balance payroll software was made by Scharrer, supported by Block. Motion carried.

A motion of joint resolution in support of the library CD-ROM project Michigan Equity Grant Application was approved by motion of Scharrer supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

A motion to transfer \$2,000 from contingency to recreation was made by Strong, supported by Block. Motion carried.

Supervisor discussed water/sewer lines on Beyer in front of park. he suggested hooking park into both lines. Supervisor will investigate costs.

Supervisor explained most recent 911 proposal. County commissioner Walt Frahm also discussed this. The aim is for a contract by the end of the year.

Frahm requested a leter stating our agreement with the proposal. Clerk will send the letter.
