Roger Ellsworth addressed the board in regard to government support of his company. The clerk has sent a letter of non-opposition to Pulse Ambulance to their attorney.

Supervisor explained most recent 911 proposal. Board approved plan in general.

Clerk reported on park projects and grants workship she attended. She also reported on sesquicentennial status.
