WHEREAS Birch Run Township wishes the record to show that it strongly opposes and resents this attempt by the Michigan Mobile Home Commission to usurp local government's constitutional rights and authority to make and enforce its zoning laws.

WHEREAS the courts held in the Robinson Township vs. Knoll case on Feb. 23, 1981 that local units of government have the right to make reasonable requirements for mobile homes outside of mobile home parks.

WHEREAS the courts held in the Bunkerhill Township vs. Goodnoe on May 17, 1983 that their zoning ordinance is valid and does not discriminiate against mobile homes.

WHEREAS we believe that to allow lower standards for mobile homes than for site built housing would be discrimination against site built housing.

WHEREAS we believe it to be a slap in the face of the electors of this state for the legislature of this great state to give to any commission the legislative power which should rest in them only to make rules which have the effect of law which can and do supercede and make null and void ordinances passed by the duly elected officers of local units of governments, and

WHEREAS we believe it ludicrous for appointed commissions to be doing what local elected officials should do.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Michigan Mobile Home Authority be denied any and all rights to make and or enforce any rule, regulation, or ordinance regarding mobile homes outside mobile home parks,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township of Birch Run will work by any and all legal means to remove from office any legislator who aids or abets the Mobile Home Commission and the Mobile Home Association in this attempt at the rape and defilement of local government.
