A motion to amend the township capital outlay budget from 1800 to 7000 through transfer from contingency fund was made by Block, supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

A motion to amend fire dept; supplies and equipment from 3,000 to 6,000 through transfer from contingency fund was made by Scharrer, supported by Dorr. Motion carried.

A motion to amend contingency fund from \$5,000 to \$20,000 was made by Block, supported by Scharrer. Motion carried.

A motion to change flail mower rate to \$20 per hour for township residents and \$30 for non-residents was made by Strong, supported by Scharrer. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by 8:30 by Scharrer supported by Strong. Motion carried.
