Supervisor reported on State Tax Commission Study of township properties. They have requested an agricultural increase of 6%; commercial, 10%; and residential 8%. Supervisor is in process of making these conditions.

Motion to pay Harry Sargent \$200 per year as Hammond Cemetery sexton was made by Strong, supported by Foster. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adjourn was made by Foster and supported by Block at 8:10 p.m. Motion passed unaimously.
