

SPECIAL MEETING March 1, 1990

The special meeting was called to order at 8 p.m. by Chairman Harold Scharrer.

Members present were Cliff White, Carol Post, Joanne Strahm and Harold Scharrer.

Approximately 6 residents were in attendance.

Previous meeting minutes were approved as read.

Meeting was called at request of planning commission for interpretation of zoning ordinance section 1614 (10) (f) as it relates to aged parent and temporary dwellings specifically would the intent of the ordinance allow an uncle, in this case Frank Kerns, to qualify as the aged parent of Patsy Cribbens and could the parent reside in the permanent dwelling and the caretaker in the temporary dwelling.

After discussion and audience comment White made the motion to interpret the ordinance per the definition that an aged parent must be a parent-child relationship as set forth in Chapter 2-Section 202 (3) as one who is completely dependent on their child or children for physical support and that the regulation requires that the aged parent live in a mobile home while the caretaker lives in the permanent dwelling. Strahm supported the motion. Motion carried.
