PUBLIC HEARING 87-1 August 5, 1987

Chairman Bailer called hearing to order at 7:30 p.m. Commission members present--Bailer, Block, Hutchinson, Knoll and Reed. Absent--Hauck and Trinklein.

Public notice 87-1 was read. It concerned a special use permit for Pentecostal Holiness Church on the Rock, located at 13613 Dixie Highway, Birch Run.

The Reverend Leslie Glasco, Jr. and the Reverend Leslie Glasco, III spoke on behalf of the church, stating their wish to establish said church, not a church camp, on purchased property. Noting improvements in appearance have already been made. Their intention is to insulate pole barn type building on property and in the future improve other existing out buildings. At present there is a membership of thirty-two people. Also stated was possiblity of holding vacation Bible School and Camp Meetings in the future. These to be held for one week in the summer.

Dora Burgess spoke of disturbance from groups using property in the past. She stated she was not opposed to a church only to noise.

Dick Wright questioned current zoning of property. Duane DeCaire also questioned noise in the area. Barbara Mazur questioned large crowds in the area also concerned if people would seek funds from area people.

Hutchinson read Section 4 and 5 of Chapter 16 explaining permit expiration and revocation.

Chairman Bailer stated he would check to see if it would be possible to not allow any outside Public Address system.

Bailer called for a vote on the special use permit. Vote was unanimous in allowing permit.
